

set protocols dot1x filter sequence from vlan

The **set protocols dot1x filter sequence from vlan** command configures the VLAN ID information of the matching packets based on the NAC-based ACL rules.

Command Syntax

set protocols dot1x filter *<filter-name>* **sequence** *<sequence-number>* **from vlan** *<vlan-id>*

Parameter

Parameter	Description
filter <i><filter-name></i>	Specifies the ACL filter name. The value is a string.
sequence <i><sequence-number></i>	Specifies filter sequence number. The value is an integer that ranges from 0 to 9999.
vlan <i><vlan-id></i>	Specifies a VLAN ID. The value is an integer that ranges from 1 to 4094.

Example

- Configure the VLAN ID of packets that match ACL rules to 100.

admin@Xorplus# set protocols dot1x filter f1 sequence 2 from vlan 100
