

set protocols igmp-snooping vlan-id querier address

The **set protocols igmp-snooping vlan-id querier address** command configures the source IP address of the general query message and group-specific query message sent by the querier.

Command Syntax

set protocols igmp-snooping vlan-id *<vlan-id>* **querier address** *<querier-address>*

Parameter

Parameter	Description
vlan-id <i><vlan-id></i>	Specifies a VLAN ID. The value is an integer that ranges from 1 to 4094.
querier address <i><querier-address></i>	Specifies a source IP address. The value is in dotted decimal notation. The default value is 0.0.0.0.

Usage Guidelines

After the Layer 2 device enables the querier function, you can run this command to configure the source IP address of the general query message and group-specific query message sent by the querier.

Example

- Configure the source IP address of the general query message and group-specific query message sent by the querier.
